## Next steps:

- ! Translation of all developed materials and resources in all partner languages

- ! Induction training with 20 parents and guardians in each partner country to raise awareness of environmental issues and to support parents and guardians in their role as facilitators of family learning

- ! Piloting of the in-service training programme for 2 educators from each partner county that is scheduled to be held in Croatia. If pandemic won't allow this, than training will be held in the online environment.

## In the first 12 months of the project, partners have:

Developed the suite of 12 monthly themed **comic strips** addressing different environmental themes.

Developed **digital breakout challenges** addressing key environmental themes to introduce the concepts and philosophy driving the circular economy, both in positive and negative scenarios

Designed **WebQuest challenges** that present real-world scenarios related to environmental issues in both positive and negative scenarios and tasks for learners to complete.

Developed an **online interactive portal** with the purpose to support a wide range of innovative online course-ware
